


<p><b>Knowledge</b></p> <p><b>Piet Mondrian 1872-1944</b> He was a Dutch artist who painted using simple lines and rectangles in white, black and primary colours.</p> <p><b>Mark Rothko 1903-1970</b> He was a Russian artist who painted in big blocks of colour known as 'colour field'. He believed bold colours expressed emotions.</p> <p><b>Paul Klee 1879-1940</b> He was a Swiss artist who focused on using different types of colour.</p> <p><b>Jackson Pollock 1912-1956</b> He was an artist who invented 'drip painting', where he would use tools to drip and splatter the paint onto a large background on the floor.</p> <p><b>Wassily Kandinsky 1866-1944</b> He was an artist who thought a lot about how colours make you feel. Often he would listen to music and try to paint what he heard.</p> <p><b>Robert Delaunay 1845-1941</b> He developed a new style of painting that uses very bright colours and lots of simple shapes.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>Squares with concentric circle – Kandinsky</b></p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p><b>Composition – Mondrian</b></p> </div>		<p><b>Vocabulary</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Primary colours</b> – red, yellow and blue</li> <li>• <b>Secondary colours</b> – orange, green and purple</li> <li>• <b>Neutral colours</b> – brown, black, grey and white</li> <li>• <b>Tints</b> – colours that have white added to them</li> <li>• <b>Shades</b> – colours that have black added to them</li> <li>• <b>Did you know? Colour mixing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Red + Blue = Purple</li> <li>○ Red + Yellow = Orange</li> <li>○ Yellow + Blue = Green</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Tinting</b> changes a colour from bright to pale. Pink is a tint made from red and white.</li> <li>• <b>Shading</b> changes a colour from bright to dark. It can make a painting seem sad, serious or even angry.</li> </ul>
