<p><b>Knowledge</b></p> <p>Chembakolli is a small village in the south of India, which is in Asia.</p> <p>It is near the equator. This means it is hot and dry for most of the year.</p> <p>There are just 2 seasons – wet and dry.</p> <p>There are sometimes floods between June and September.</p> <p>The land around Chembakolli is hilly and covered in forest.</p> <p>Schools are in the open air and children do lessons sitting on the floor.</p> <p>There is no electricity or running water.</p> <p>The villagers collect their water from a well.</p> <p>Many villagers are farmers.</p> <p>Most houses in Chembakolli are huts made of straw and mud.</p>		<p><b>Vocabulary</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Amenities</b> - useful features or facilities.</li> <li>• <b>Differences</b> - things that are not the same.</li> <li>• <b>Employment</b> - the jobs people do.</li> <li>• <b>Facilities</b> - something provided for a particular purpose.</li> <li>• <b>Feature</b> - a distinctive aspect of something.</li> <li>• <b>Landscape</b> - The visible features of an area of land.</li> <li>• <b>Location</b> - where something is.</li> <li>• <b>Population</b> - all of the people who live in a particular place.</li> <li>• <b>Similarities</b> - things that are the same.</li> <li>• <b>Town</b> - a large group of houses, shops and factories where people live.</li> <li>• <b>Village</b> - a small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside.</li> <li>• <b>Villager</b> - a person who lives in a village.</li> <li>• <b>Weather</b> - the day-to-day outdoor conditions such as temperature and rainfall.</li> </ul>
