Topic: That's a Date

Prior Knowledge

- Hold basic greetings conversation
- Know the colours, days of the week and months of the year.
- Know numbers 1-20
- Should be able to write simple sentences from memory containing 10 words.
- Can tell the time to the hour, quarter to and quarter past.
- Knows names of school subjects and names of places in school
- Can introduce a place in school

Activities

- Share time of WW2. Count to 20 in ones and to 100 in 10s. Play games to consolidate.
- Demonstrate how to write key dates. Practise writing key dates using set phrase
- Practise writing important dates from own family/life
- Discuss Battle of Britain
- Order key details
- Use translation dictionaries to find key words to deduce meaning
- Make a pie using wartime recipe

Vocabulaire:

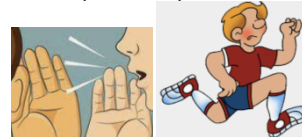
Key dates:

1940 = **mille neuf cent quarante**
 1939 = **mille neuf cent trente neuf**
 1944 = **mille neuf cent quarante quatre**



Instructions :

- cach – cachez** (Hide!)
- chuchot – chuchotez** (Whisper!)
- cour – courez** (Run!)
- avance– avancez** (Advance!)
- salue – saluez** (Salute!)
- arrête arrêtez** (Stop!)
- défile – défilez** (March!)



Useful daily phrases/words:

- **Montrez-moi** - show me
- **Dépêche-toi! / vite** - hurry up!
- **Bravo!** - well done
- **Qui peut compter sur..?** - Who can count to...?
